NOTES:

If additional National Motor Museum staff are required to assist in the set-up of the function or event, a rate of \$40 per hour per person applies. This fee will also apply if staff are required outside of normal hours i.e. before 9.00am or after 5.00pm.

We can recommend a variety of caterers depending on the type, style and budget.

Any electrical item brought on site by hirer or caterer must be electrically tested and tagged.

All stalls must be provided with our Stall Registration, Information Sheet, Contractor Sign In and site plan and they must supply a Certificate of Currency of their public liability cover and in the case of caterers, proof of Council acceptance as a food provider.

Please talk to the Museum staff about promotion of your event and how we can assist.

For all events over 50 vehicles, qualified (SAPOL Marshal trained) parking marshals are required. The Museum can supply marshals if a club doesn't have appropriately trained members.

We have a commitment to ensure the safety of employees, volunteers, contractors and visitors to the National Motor Museum. In the event that a Fire Danger Rating CATASTROPHIC (Code Red) Level is declared by the CFS for the Mount Lofty District, the Museum will be closed. Should this occur, we will endeavour to contact you as soon as possible to advise you of the closure, however it is your responsibility to arrange an alternative venue.
